WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

You will be able to recycle more than you could before!

At each Depot there will be 1) commingled recycling 2) glass only 3) cardboard only.

Commingled Recycling Guide

YES! Thanks for recycling these items! All items must be empty and dry.

PLASTIC



**BOTTLES • ROUND CONTAINERS
BUCKETS • RIGID PLANT POTS**

Caps OK if screwed on. All items must be 2 inches by 2 inches or larger.

METAL



**ALUMINUM AND STEEL CANS
SCRAP METAL**

Less than 10 pounds and 18 inches.

CARDBOARD & CARTONS



**FLATTENED CARDBOARD
PACKAGING BOXES
FOOD & BEVERAGE CARTONS**

Pizza boxes must be empty with no food residue.

**NEWSPAPER • MAGAZINES • MAIL
OFFICE PAPER • EGG CARTONS
PAPERBACK BOOKS • BAGS

TOP 10 Recycling Tips

- 1 KNOW THE ACCEPTED ITEMS:** Refer to our website for the list of what you can recycle (e.g. metal, paper, cardboard, plastic bottles).
- 2 EMPTY AND DRY:** Make sure it's empty and let it dry before recycling.
- 3 FLATTEN BOXES:** Save space and make collection easier by flattening cardboard boxes.
- 4 SCREW LIDS AND CAPS ON:** Lids and caps are okay if screwed onto plastic bottles.
- 5 AVOID SMALL ITEMS:** Items must be larger than 2 inches by 2 inches to be recycled (e.g. bottle caps, straws).
- 6 KNOW WHAT TO THROW:** Only place items you're sure are recyclable—when in doubt, throw it out.
- 7 CLEAN PAPER AND CARDBOARD:** Remove grease and food before recycling paper or cardboard (for example, tear off greasy parts of pizza boxes).
- 8 NO SHARP OBJECTS:** Never recycle knives, needles, or other sharp materials—they are hazardous to workers.
- 9 KEEP GLASS SEPARATE:** Glass has its own recycle box, please keep separate to reduce contamination.
- 10 NO BAGGED RECYCLABLES:** Keep items loose. No bags!
